Economic interests and values as a core element of national economic security

Research methodology. Problem analysis was carried out using a systematic approach, which made it possible to identify the place of economic interests and values in economic security provision in times of economic globalization. Methods of scientific abstraction and from simple to complex, as well as functional and logical analysis allowed to investigate the interdependence and consistency of bearing elements of national economic security.

Results. It was proved that the national economic interests are integral in their nature, they are characterized by internal contradictions, which can be solved by introducing of the additional element to the system of economic security – economic values. The relation between the contradictions of economic interests and causes of economic hazards at the national level was identified.

Novelty. Methodological approaches to the analysis of national economic security system in terms of the globalization development of the world economy, which are based on the concept of multiple-level system of economic interests confrontation, were offered. The concept of "compatibility of macro-, micro- and mega-levels of economic interests" was proposed. It was proved that the national economic security is a mean of national economic interests and values preserving.

Practical significance. On the basis of the improved methodology of the national economic security analysis the recommendations on the components of the mechanism of its maintenance were made.
