Research Methodology: Systemic approach is used for the scientific approaches to the determination of food security through its resource provision. A lot of consideration is given to modern interpretation of production potential. By means of dialectical and abstractly logical methods the reproductive-resource approach to understanding of food security essence are estimated.

Results: The features in interpretation of «food security» concept are revealed by different scientists. The resource provision of food security is investigated, which determines reproductive processes in the agroindustrial complex. A role and value of production potential, as well as its influence on food security in the system of economic security is revealed.
