The redistributive function of the state in Ukraine

Research methodology: On the basis of the application of the comparative analysis the relationship between the amount of GDP redistributed through the use of the state budget and the effective social policy was investigated. With the help of economic and statistical methods the share of the state budget in the GDP of Ukraine and other countries of the word was estimated.

Results: The clear dependence of the possibility of state social effective policy conduction from a share of GDP redistributed through the use of the state budget was shown. The share of the state budget of Ukraine's GDP compared to other countries was estimated. The conclusion that there are serious problems with the pumping up of the budget of Ukraine because of the huge volume of the shadow economy and corruption in government was made. It was proposed to move from proportional to progressive taxation of people incomes.

Novelty: The direct correlation between the share of the state budget in the country's GDP and effectiveness of the state to perform its redistributive functions was shown. The degree of compliance of the specified index in Ukraine to the adopted European standards was assessed.

The practical significance: The objective dependence of the efficiency of state social policy from a share of GDP redistributed through the state budget was confirmed. Practical recommendations for increasing of budget revenues in Ukraine, due to adjustments in public policy of income taxation were developed.
